




	<u>Inflatable Kayak or Raft</u>	Starts: 8:30 am
	<p><i>The Jatunyaku River for big waves or the Anzu for a more relaxing time with smaller rapids.</i></p> <p>Inflatable Kayak: 2 to 4 (possibly 5) people at \$70 a person. Full Day Raft: \$60 per person (min. 4).</p>	<p><u>Duration:</u> Kayak: 4-5 hrs. Raft: 6-7 hrs</p>
	<u>Day Jungle Tour</u>	Starts: 8:30 am
	<p>Visit and feed grapes to the playful monkeys in Misahualli, then take a motor canoe trip from there to a chocolate making demo out in the jungle, an amazing butterfly farm, a riverside picnic lunch, and AmaZOOnico Animal Rehab Center!</p> <p>Cost: <u>The more people that go, the lower the per person price!</u> When we have 9 or 10 participants sign up by the time of the tour, the cost is an amazing \$60 per person! 8 go for \$65 pp, 7 for \$70, 6 for \$75, 5 for \$85, and 4 for \$95. <i>(If we only have 2 people sign up by the time of the tour, we can still go, but the price will be close to that for 3 people.)</i></p>	<p>Duration: 10 hrs.</p>
	<u>Hike to Latas Waterfall</u> “Cascadas Latas” in Spanish	<u>Start time</u> <u>Duration</u>
	<p>Cost: 3 and up at \$32 per person, max is 8.</p>	10:30 am 4 hrs.
	Go/add on <u>caving</u> for \$18 per person, min. 3 people.	8:30 am 2 hrs.
	Add on a trip to Misahualli to <u>visit the beach monkeys</u> afterward for \$12 per person, min. 3 people.	2 – 2 ½ hrs.
	If adding on the beach monkeys, you can also add on a <u>dusk lagoon float</u> for \$13 per person, min. 3 people. (This can also be done as a stand-alone tour. Cost would be \$60 for 2 people, plus \$10 for each additional participant.)	2 – 2 ½ hrs.
	If we only have 2 people sign up by the time of the tour, we can still go, but the price will be close to that for 3 people.	
	<u>Overnight Jungle Tour</u>	Starts: 9:00 am
	<p>Visit with the monkeys in Misahualli on the way to a lodge in the jungle. Check out the primary rainforest with a day jungle hike and a night jungle walk. That’s just the first day, the second day wake up early for a dawn bird watching tour along the banks of the Napo in a canoe, then go on to a chocolate making demonstration, an amazing butterfly farm, and have a picnic lunch along the river. Finish up with a visit to an animal Rehab Center!</p> <p>Cost: 2 and up at \$200 per person, max is 8</p>	<p>Duration: 2 days</p>
